Application Process

Students enrolled at Sinclair Community College with the intent to enroll in a program within the College of Science and Mathematics at Wright State University may apply for this scholarship. The scholarship totals \$2500 renewable for a total of two academic years at Wright State University. Students must receive their associate's degree by August 2014 to be eligible for this scholarship.

In addition, students must:

- Complete an Associate's Degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 and completion of one college Algebra course with a grade of C or better.
- Apply and be accepted to Wright State. It is recommended to apply at <u>www.wright.edu/undergraduate-admissions/apply</u> at least 3 months prior to the start of the term.
- Submit your final transcript no later than the end of their first term at Wright State University.
- Complete the college scholarship application available in the dean's Student Services office, 106 Oelman Hall and return it Attention: Joyce Howes.

Scholarship recipients must:

- Maintain full-time status, which is at least 12 credit hours, at Wright State University.
- Maintain a qualifying cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 in a science and mathematics discipline at Wright State University.
